LUNCH PROCEDURES

During lunchtime at SMS, our Grade 7 and 8 classes will eat their lunch in their CORE classrooms while our grade 9 students eat their lunches in the Open Area.



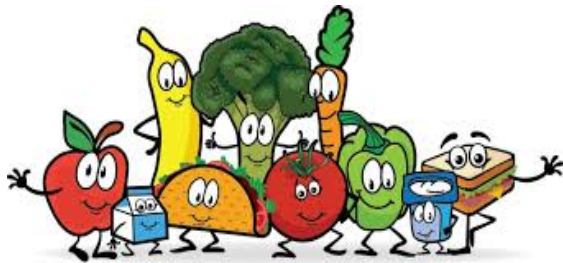
All students are able to take advantage of the following: **Healthy Brown Bag Lunches**- students in need of a lunch may go to Room 156 at lunch to get one of our brown bag lunches and/or fruit/snacks.

Soup- we will begin our hot soup program soon. One day a week, we will be making soup and buns available by donation. Students are asked to pay \$0.50 or what they are able for a cup of soup and a bun.

Canteen – our Canteen is open at lunchtime and break-time offering snacks and drinks. We will be starting our HOT LUNCH program soon. Order forms will be sent home with all students soon.

Canteen Cards - are available for students to purchase in the office in the denominations of \$5, \$10, \$20 and \$25.

We offer a **Breakfast Club** each morning in the Open Area beginning at 8:15. We also have fresh fruit available each day for students needing a snack during the day.



LUNCHTIME ACTIVITIES

There are a number of activities for students each day at SMS, including:

Outside Equipment: We have a number of soccer balls, basketballs, Frisbees, and other equipment available for students to use outside.

Library: Our library is open for students at lunchtime for a quiet place to complete work, read a book, or talk quietly with friends.

Computer Lab: Our computer lab in the Library is open every lunch for student use. Priority is given to students completing schoolwork.

The Gym: Our gym is open every day for students to play basketball, volleyball or other activities.

Intramurals: We will be starting our intramural games in the next few weeks.

Good Communication....

We believe that communication with our Parents, Guardians, and our entire school community is incredibly important. Skeena Middle School has begun using an automated callout system. If our secretaries are unable to contact parents, we are implementing the use of this system to call parents and guardians to notify you that your son/daughter is away from school. This system will also be used to notify all of our parents/guardians about the events (e.g. Open House, Report Cards, Parent/Teacher Interviews, etc.) at Skeena Middle School.



Student Pick-Up and Drop Off

We have had new signs installed and painted to ensure that our traffic flow is moving along. We would like to remind all of our parents/guardians to follow the signs indicating the "Drop Off" Area in our front parking lot.

All parents/guardians are reminded that our bus lane (the lane closest to the building) is reserved for school buses only until 4:30 pm.

Our first PAC (Parent Advisory Council) Meeting of the year is scheduled for this Wednesday, September 20, beginning at 7:00 p.m. in the school library.

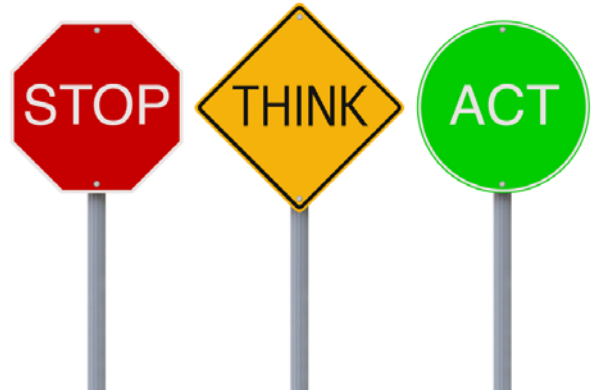

SAFETY TO AND FROM SCHOOL

- We all care about student safety. It is important that we continually stress the importance of using crosswalks, sidewalks and overpasses, and frequently remind students about following safe traffic and road rules.
- Talk to your child about taking extra caution near busy intersections and corners.
- Students should be cautious and fully aware of their surroundings and avoid using their cell phones and listening to loud music.
- Skateboards, longboards, and scooters can be brought to school; however, it is crucial for students to follow safety and road rules. It is also essential that those riding skateboards, longboards, or scooters to and from school have the necessary equipment to protect their own personal safety. Helmets are a required piece of equipment.
- If your child is bringing a skateboard, longboard or scooter they must bring these items into the office as soon as they arrive on school grounds. Students are not permitted to ride these before class, at lunch or break, or after school.
- If your child is bringing a bike to school, they must lock this up as soon as they arrive on grounds. Bikes are not to be ridden on school grounds.
