Welcome to the 2024 Northwest Jr Girls A Zone Tournament. We are anticipating a great tournament with a high level of play and excellent sportsmanship displayed to our community.

Tournament Location:

- All Friday games and the Elimination games Saturday will take place at HSS
- The teams that finish outside of the top 6 will play consolation games at HCS Saturday morning. As noted in the schedule.

Tournament Fee:

- The tournament fee for each team is \$100. Please bring a check payable to "Houston Christian School Sport Fees" to the tournament or etransfer to kim.vanb@houstonchristianschool.ca memo: Jr girls A volleyball zones. Awards:
- A banner will be awarded to the Championship team
- There will be medals given to the 1st and 2nd place teams.
- One Tournament MVP award will be granted

Rosters:

- Please have a team list of your roster with player uniform numbers ready before each match and provided to the scorer's table at least 20 minutes before each match
- Coaches must sign scoresheets to verify rosters at the beginning of the match
- Team Captains must sign scoresheets at the end of the match to verify the score Lines
- Linesmen will be provided for the semis, bronze and gold medal games
- Each team must provide one linesman for each of their games reading up to the semis

Rules:

- BC High School Volleyball rules will be in effect:
- o Teams may have as many players as they wish on their roster however teams may dress a maximum of 15 players per match during zone and provincial championships. The 15 dressed players may change from match to match
- o 12 subs "unlimited" per set plus libero
- o Dangling jewelry which presents a danger to participants is to be removed.
- o Teams may play the ball off the ceiling (including overhead obstructions) provided that the contact with the ceiling takes place above the floor within the court and free zone and the ball does not cross into the opponents playing space immediately after contacting the ceiling or obstruction.

o All matches will be best of 3 with no caps

TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES (Volleyball Canada)

If two or more teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round, the following criteria will be applied, in order:

- a. the team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- b. The team having the best ratio of won/lost sets, considering matches played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- c. The team having the best ratio of won/lost sets, considering all matches of the round, will be ranked higher;
- d. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering sets played between the tied teams, will be ranked higher;
- e. The team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all sets played during the round, will be ranked higher;
- f. As determined by the Organizing Committee (e.g. extra set, toss of coin, etc.)

When you apply this rule to break a tie you should follow this sequence:

- 1. When two teams are tied, the tie-breaking criteria are applied one after the other until the tie has been broken.
- 2. When three or more teams are tied, the tie-breaking criteria are applied one after the other until all the tied teams have been ranked.

NOTE: This means that if there is a tie among teams X, Y and Z and criteria "b" is able to determine X as first, Y as second and Z as third, then no further criteria are to be used. The tie is broken.

However, if criteria 'b' determines the seeding/ranking of any of the tied teams, then the remaining teams which are still tied will use criteria 'c' and so on to determine their seeding/ranking. Do not start at 'a' again. Continue through the sequence of criteria using the results of teams x, y, and z for criteria 'd'.
